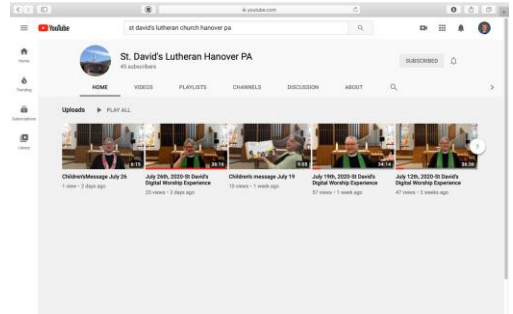

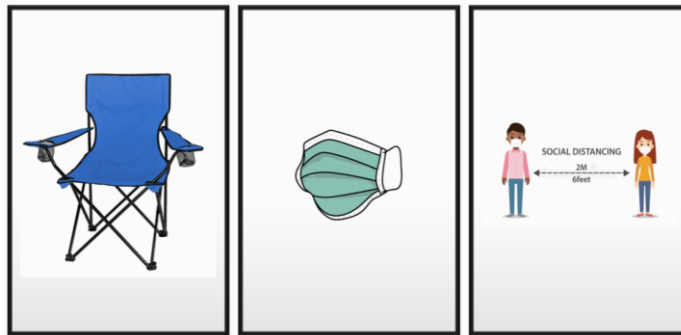
In-person worship is held outside in our pavilion on Sundays at 9:00 A.M. and 10:45 A.M. Those attending will be prepared to:

In this time when we can't be together in our usual ways, it's important to stay tuned to our church communications for the latest news and to help you stay grounded in your faith. We communicate in the following ways:

By email through Constant Contact service.

- Weekly announcements, including a link to our YouTube worship service, are emailed on Saturdays.
- Pastor LaDonna emails a pastoral reflection and announcements on Tuesdays
- Monthly newsletter is emailed at the beginning each month.
- Any urgent news such as the death of a member, or emergency requests for help are emailed, as needed

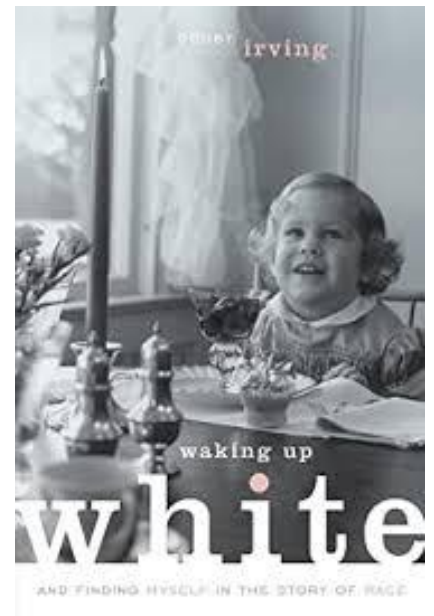
Connects a recent news story with conversations about our Christian faith.
